The show will be held indoors on mats over cement. Rings will be fully-matted.

Limited socially distanced grooming and crating for conformation will be indoors adjacent to the ring.

Limited socially distanced indoor crating for obedience and rally will be available on concrete.

Outdoor crating and/or grooming is encouraged, weather permitting.

NO CHALKING. NO AIR-FORCED DRYERS. No Aerosol products THANKS FOR CLEANING UP AFTER YOUR DOGS AND YOUR SET-UP.

There will **NOT** be a food booth. Fast food restaurants are near by, on 12th Ave So and Nicollet Ave.

There will be NO electricity or Hook-ups for RV amenities.

Show grounds will be available at 7:30 AM on Saturday 4/10/2021 and 7:15 AM Sunday 4/11/2021.

A photographer MAY be available for win shots.

Conformation entries for each show shall close at the gate entry deadline, as stated on the front of the flyer, which will be prior to the judging of the first class of that show.

Conformation Rosettes: BOBP, BOSP, BJH, RJH, (Altered and Intact) WD, RWD, WB, RWB, BOB, BOS, BOW Ribbons for 1st through 4th.

Obedience and Rally Rosettes: HIT, HSA, HSO, HC, HSJ Ribbons for 1st through 4th and Qualifying, and Rally "X" ribbons

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA.

All dogs six months of age or over at the show site must have a current rabies vaccine certificate in their owners' possession.

All Australian Shepherds six months of age and older must be able to show proof of ASCA registration to be eligible for showing

Dogs showing threatening behavior will be subject to either disqualification or excusal, per the ASCA Dog Aggression Rules. All UMASC investigations and appropriate forms will be forwarded on to the ASCA Business office. Dogs excused or disqualified under said policy, will be excused from the remainder of the events and asked to leave, without refund of entry fees.

Dogs **appearing** to show clinical symptoms of distemper, infectious hepatitis, parvovirus, leptospirosis, kennel cough or other communicable diseases will be **asked to leave the event, without refund of entry fees.**

COVID19 INFORMATION MUST BE READ AND RULES FOLLOWED BY ALL EXHIBITORS AND PERSONS IN ATTENDANCE!!!!!

- 1. Clubs, officials, participants and anyone attending the show are required to follow State, Local and facility guidelines that apply to the area and site where the event is held.
- 2. Be respectful. Not all of our participants have the same level of comfort being out and about at this time. Practice social distancing consistent with guidelines in effect at the time of the event. Avoid congregating to the extent possible. Chairs, crates and grooming should be spaced out 6' apart unless you are attending with other individuals.
- 3. The number of people allowed in the building at one time will be determined by State and County guidelines. All those who are not actively participating in showing, prepping, or grooming need to stay home. We HIGHLY RECOMMEND THAT YOU CONSIDER THAT YOUNG CHILDREN (PeeWee/Sub Junior) OR ELDERLY SHOULD NOT ATTEND.
- 4. Should you choose to disrupt the show in any way the show committee retains the right to ask anyone to leave the grounds. Again, please be respectful of others.
- 5. In the building and ring judge's and exhibitors will be wearing masks. On the grounds/parking lot, consider wearing masks when in close proximity to others.
- 6. Conformation pre-entries a HIGHLY ENCOURAGED to reduce the face to face contact the secretary has with exhibitors. There will be a separate table with entry forms for DOS entries that must be filled out before approaching the secretary. Please remain 6' away unless asked to step forward.
- 7. The Ring will have two gates, an entrance & exit. Each will be marked.
- 8. Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility. Avoid common use pens/pencils etc. Please bring your own.
- 9. UMASC will disinfect surfaces in common use areas as often as possible (tables, chairs, etc.)
- 10. Know the armband numbers and class entered for your entries before going to the ring. Do not congregate at the ring or ring gate. While showing your dog maintain social distance from other exhibitors. Be prepared to show your dog's bite. Please give the judge plenty of personal space as you exhibit your dog.


Driving directions to show site: Take 35W to County Road 13-East exit, then follow County Road 13 to the stoplight at13 and Portland (Burnsville Senior High School is on the North side of 13).

Turn right and go South on Portland to the first left turn into the parking lot.

Or, take Highway 77 (Cedar Avenue) to Cliff Road (County Road 32), then take Cliff Road West to the intersection of County Road 13. Take a left turn and go West on County Road 13 until you get to the light at Portland (Burnsville Senior High School on right).

Turn left and go South on Portland to the first left turn into the parking lot.
